Your Individual Rights



The right to object to the use of your personal information

You can only object to processing when the organisation is using your data for:



scientific or historical research, or statistical purposes



PUBLIC FUNCTIONS OR LEGITIMATE INTERESTS HISTORICAL O

Organisations must give you the right to object:

- · When they first communicate with you
- · Must state this explicitly, and
- · Separately from other things they've told you

They must stop processing if you ask them to.

They MUST stop processing if you ask them to.



It will NOT apply if public interest outweighs your rights

HISTORICAL OR SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES

Organisations must stop processing, unless:

- It's in the public interest
- Public interest outweighs your interests



Organisations must give you the right to object:

- When they first communication with you
- Must state this explicitly, and
